BIOGRAPHY

Francisco Thoumi is currently a Professor of Economics and the Director of the Research and Monitoring Center on Drugs and Crime, Universidad del Rosario, Bogotá, Colombia. He is also a member of the Board of Directors of the Colombian Economics Academy.

From August 1999 to September 2000, he was the research coordinator for the Global Program against Money Laundering, United Nations Office of Drug Control and Crime Prevention. He was a fellow of the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars in Washington, D.C. from 1996 to 1997. He was the regional coordinator for the United Nations research program on the economic effects of the illegal drug industry in Bolivia, Colombia and Peru from 1993-1996. He was a Professor and Director of the Center for International Studies, Universidad de Los Andes, Bogotá, from 1994-1995. He was a research associate for the United Nations Research Institute for Social Development (UNRISD) from 1991 to 1992. .

Previous positions include Director, International Relations Center, Universidad de Los Andes, Bogotá; Professor in the Department of Economics, California State University Chico, CA; Section Chief, Economic and Social Development Department, Inter-American American Development Bank; Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, George Washington University; Economist, Economic Development Department, World Bank; and Section Chief, National Planning Department of Colombia.

He has authored numerous books, over 45 book chapters and 90 academic journal articles on the subject of illegal drugs.
